Numeracy

- Create some Scottish-themed word problems
- Work out the distance between major Scottish cities in miles, kilometres, and metres
- Can you find out:
 - *How many passengers were on board the Titanic?*
 - *How long was the Titanic?*
 - *How many lifeboats were there on the Titanic?*
 - *How many people survived the Titanic disaster?*
 - *How many funnels did the Titanic have?*
- Research to find the lengths of cruise liners today. Make a poster showing the size of different cruise liners compared to the size of the Titanic

Out and About!

- Visit your local library. Find some non-fiction books about Scotland/Titanic
- Make a paper boat that floats in the sea. What did you do?
- Design a life jacket using materials that would help someone stay afloat

Literacy

- Write an imaginative story about a King or Queen of Scotland
- Write a song or a poem to celebrate Scotland
- Create your own list of rules for Scotland
- Make an informative poster about a famous Scottish King or Queen
- Read a novel with a Scottish theme
- Make a word search with Scottish words
- Make an acrostic poem about the Titanic
- Write a newspaper report about the Titanic disaster
- Make a tourist information leaflet about New York

Working with Others

- Create a Scottish/Titanic-themed board or card game, and teach friends or family members how to play.
- Work with a friend or family member to design your own ship. Draw and label any unique features.
- Discuss facts about the Titanic with an adult. Work with an adult to create a 'Top Three Titanic Facts' list.
- Make up a Scotland/Titanic quiz! You need to know the answers!

Expressive Arts

- Create a painting or drawing of a Scottish scene using your choice of materials
- Ask your friends and family to help you create a list with as many song titles that you know of Scottish songs

- Write a Scottish rap or song.
- Design an outfit for a first class passenger on board the Titanic
- Design a ticket for the Titanic
- Design a lifeboat

- Find out and write down ten amazing facts about the Titanic
- Make your own model of the Titanic

Health and Wellbeing

- Explain to an adult the rights that different social classes of passengers had on board the Titanic
- Research to find out about food available on the Titanic

- What ten things would you take with you on the Titanic? Write a list and give a reason for each object.
